In 2021 Swarthmore College adopted To Zero By Thirty-Five (formerly known as the Roadmap to Zero Carbon) to achieve carbon neutrality by 2035. Key elements of the plan are energy efficiency upgrades and a new geoexchange system. Andy Feick (Associate Vice President of Sustainable Facilities Operations & Capital Planning) and Jim Adams, PE (Director of Sustainable Energy Services) will guide attendees on a tour of Phase 1 of the geoexchange well field; the PERT pipe installations that serve the low temperature hot water distribution system; and the new geoexchange plant under construction in the basement of the College's new all-electric, highly sustainable Dining Center.
